Release Update – May 8, 2020

What's New:

- Added URL Import feature to allow users the ability to identify the exact URL they want scanned as part of their subscription.
- Updated the free scan page (<https://app.iAccessible.com/Scan>) to scan 5 URL was launched to provide an improved user experience and additional information to users exploring iAccessible's capabilities.
- Free scan page no longer requires the `http://` and `https://`, and automatically accommodate how a user naturally inputs a URL.
- Deployed an updated free scan email to better summarize the free scan results to better align with the accessibility reporting strategies of iAccessible.
- The overall dashboard was reorganized for a more enjoyable experience.
- Organizations are now able to filter their different subscriptions, company, or departments on all the dashboards, allowing for a more granular evaluation.
- Created summary tables to archive data older than 90 days, allowing for improve dashboard performance and end user experience.
- In the detailed reports dashboard, users can now scan pages that have already been scanned during their most recent subscription period. This provides developers with current data before beginning the remediation process.
- Updated heat map colors to make them easier to see.
- Moved placement of the department and organization filter options to create a more familiar user experience.

Bugs Fixed:

- The methodology of how data was saved was changed to protect performance as the database grew.
- Organizations filters did not always filter. This has been resolved.
- The responsiveness of the overall dashboard caused elements to overlap other elements. This has been resolved.
- Users are no longer restricted to one trial of the free scan page.
- Free scan page now validates URL's as inactive or not before scanning.
- Subscription now validates URL's as inactive or not before submitting.
